

An Act Changing and removing
 an election precinct in Nashoba County, O. T.
 Sect 1. Be it enacted by the General
 Council of the Choctaw Nation
 assembled: - That, an election
 precinct known as Sulphur Spring
 precinct in Nashoba County be and
 the same is hereby changed and removed to
 about ten miles north, to Mount Zion
 Church and shall be called and known
 hereafter as Mount Zion Precinct.

Sect 2. Be it further enacted, That the
 1st election held at said Mount Zion
 precinct shall be on the 1st Wednesday
 in August 1896; and all future
 elections shall be held there.

Sect 3. Be it further enacted, That,
 all acts or parts of acts coming in
 conflict with this provision are
 hereby repealed; and that this
 act shall take effect and be
 in force from and after its
 passage.
