Whereas, in 1893, the precinct known
as High Hill in Tobucksey County,
C.N. was abolished, and whereas,
the voters in High Hill precinct
have asked by petition to have
High Hill precinct reinstated
Therefore

Be it enacted by the general
Council of the Choctaw Nation
assembled,

That the precinct of
High Hill Precinct be reinstated
in the County of Tobucksey, C.N.
and that all citizens of Tobu-
-cksey County be privileged to
vote at said precinct in
all elections - And this act
Take effect and be in force
from and after its passage
