

An Act Changing an election precinct in Saxe  
Bois County

Be it enacted by the General Council  
of the Chocoma Nation assembled,  
That the Saxe Hill election precinct  
in Saxe Bois County, is hereby discontinued  
and instead thereof is hereby established  
four miles north west of the said  
Saxe Hill precinct and what is known  
and called Siloam Springs, a precinct  
is hereby established: Any acts, or parts  
of acts coming in conflict with this  
act is hereby repealed, and this act  
shall take effect from and after its  
passage.
