

An Act changing and removing an election precinct in Sans Bois County, C. N.

Sect I. Be it enacted by the General Council of Cherokee Nation assembled: That an election precinct known as Little Sans Bois precinct in Sans Bois County, Cherokee Nation, is hereby changed and removed to about three miles South-west to Little Sans Bois Church in said County and it shall be called and known hereafter as Little Sans Bois precinct.

Sect II. Be it further enacted; That the first election held in said precinct shall be on the 1st Wednesday in August 1896: and all future elections shall be held there.

Sect III. Be it further enacted, That all acts, or parts of acts coming in conflict with the provision of this act are hereby repealed; and that this act take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
