

An Act Making an Appropriation  
for Harrell International Insti-  
tute.

Sec. 1

Be it enacted by the  
General Council of the Choctaw  
Nation That the sum of  
five thousand six hundred  
and twenty five dollars is  
hereby appropriated to defray  
the expenses of thirty boys  
and fifteen girls at Harrell  
International Institute at  
Muskogee Ind. Ter. during  
this present session. The above  
sum shall be placed subject  
to the orders of the Supr. of  
Public Schools and the Nation-  
al Auditor shall issue his  
warrants quarterly for the  
above amount in favor of  
said School and the Treasurer  
shall pay the same.  
And this Act shall take effect  
and be in force from and after  
its passage.
