

An Act to Rebuild Spenser Academy.

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled: That the sum of seven thousand dollars (\$7000⁰⁰) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of rebuilding and making additions to the buildings at Spenser Academy sufficient for the accommodation of one hundred boys with and including the buildings already there.

That the said sum shall be paid to the Board of Education and that said Board shall contrall and over-see the work.

And the National Auditor is hereby instructed and authorized to issue his warrant for said sum and the National Treasurer shall pay the same.
