AN ACT

AMENDING AN ACT CREATING A COMMISSION TO MAKE THE FINAL ROLL OF THE
CITIZENS OF THE CHOCTAW NATION.

SEC1. *Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled,* That hereafter the said Commission shall consist of three members, one of whom shall act as clerk, That said Commission shall perform all the duties required of them, by law, and shall be subject to the orders of the Principal Chief at all times.

SEC.2. Be it further enacted-That the sum of Twenty Thousand (\$20000) dollars is hereby appropriated to carry out the purposes of said Act, and placed subject to the orders of the Principal Chief who shall render a statement to the Council of all expenditures thereunder, and shall cover back into the Treasury any unexpended balance; And that this Act take effect from and after its passage.
