

Resolution

To the General Council -

We your Committee to whom was referred the Special Message of the Principal Chief, asking a full investigation of the claim of Mrs Moore, who alleges, that her husband now deceased, did prior to his death do certain Clerical duties under a Contract made with H H Hampton - and states that she, nor did he ever receive any pay for same -

After a full and careful investigation we find that all clerical work pertaining in any manner to the case has been duly paid for, and that we fail to find any amount whatever due to Mrs Moore, and respectfully ask that her claim be ignored and respectfully ask the passage of the following resolution

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled that the claim for pay for clerical duties alleged to have been done be ignored and not paid, and that this resolution take effect and be in force from and after its passage
