Carl Luckridge, William Luckridge and George Luckridge -- Also Lafayette Weeden, brother of the applicant, and his wife Mary Weeden and their children William Weeden, George Weeden, Price Weeden, Alva Weeden, Herbert Weeden, Lester Weeden, Earnest Weeden, Benjamin Weeden, Henry Weeden and Laura Weeden; and also their grand children, being the children of George Weeden by his marriage to Maud Weeden, to wit.
