

AN ACT REPEALING AN ACT GRANTING CITIZENSHIP TO WHIT W. HYDEN ET AL.

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled-  
That the Act approved Oct. 31st. 1895 granting to Whit W. Hyden and his children Frank Hyden and Maud Hyden and Lennard Hyden and Joe Hyden and Whit Hyden and Ella Hyden and Cleveland Hyden and Benjamin Hyden and Ruth Hyden rights, privileges and immunities of citizenship in the Choctaw Nation is hereby repealed.  
And the said Whit W. Hyden and his children are hereby declared non-citizens of the Choctaw Nation.

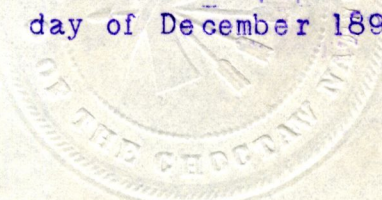
