
Sir:

You are respectfully advised that Bill No. 25, of the Choctaw Nation, entitled "An Act appropriating money to pay Wesley Anderson", and which provides:

"That the sum of twenty-five hundred dollars (\$2,500.00), is hereby appropriated to pay Wesley Anderson of Jacksfork Co., for services as Commissioner to Washington, D. C., in securing the ratification by Congress of the Agreement made at Atoka, Ind. Ter., April 23, 1897", and

which was approved by the Principal Chief of your Nation on October 25, 1898, was, on the 26th ultimo, approved by the President of the United States, and the same is herewith transmitted to you, together with the letter of the Honorable Secretary of the Interior transmitting said Act to the President for action.
