That said Committee shall proceed forthwith to Wheelock Orphan Seminary, and make full, minute, and careful investigation in the conduct, management, <sup>and</sup> condition of said Seminary.

Be it further resolved, that said Committee shall make a written report of its investigation to the present session of the Council, and shall make the same as soon
