

An Act to stop the issuance of County scrip.

Be it enacted by the general Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled:

That <sup>hereafter</sup> no clerk of any Court nor any judge of this Nation shall have the right or authority to issue any County scrip. And so much of any law or laws heretofore enacted which gave any clerk or judge the right or authority to issue County scrip be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. II Be it further enacted, That hereafter in all civil suits the plaintiff shall give proper bond for the payment off all costs, including witness fees. And the fees of all officers and witnesses in civil suits shall remain the



same as they are now.  
Sec. III Be it further enacted, That  
the fees now allowed all of-  
ficers and witnesses in Criminal  
cases before the Circuit Courts  
payable out of the National  
treasury shall remain as they  
are; but hereafter in all  
examining trials before the  
county courts no fees shall  
be allowed witnesses or of-  
ficers either out of the National  
treasury or County treasuries;  
and that this act take ef-  
fect and be in force from  
and after its passage and  
approval.
