Herewith I send you an Act of the Council of the Choctaw Nation entitled "An Act repealing an Act employing and appointing S. Guerrier Special Agent and Attorney of the Choctaw Nation." which was returned to me by the Honorable Secretary of the Interior in his letter of December 27, 1898, in which he says:-

"This act is not properly certified by the National Secretary as required by law, the certificate being signed by the principal Chief. It is therefore, returned for a proper certificate in accordance with the requirements as set forth in former letters upon the subject. When received with a proper certificate, it will be submitted to the President for his action."

In this connection, I desire to invite your attention to the fact that the two Acts returned to you with my communication of the 21st ultimo, for proper certification, which have as yet not been accomplished and returned to me for transmission to the Department for executive action. Sample forms were also sent you with said acts for your information and guidance in preparation of Acts of the Council for submission to the President according to law.
