

A RESOLUTION
AUTHORIZING THE PRINCIPAL CHIEF TO APPOINT A COMMISSION TO INVESTIGATE
AND REPORT UPON THE CONDITION OF AFFAIRS AT JONES ACADEMY.

BE IT RESOLVED, That the Principal Chief is hereby authorized and directed to appoint a commission of two members of the Council, whose duty it shall be to proceed immediately after their appointment to ^{the} school at Jones Academy and there make full, minute and careful investigation into the condition of said Academy, and especially to examine the preparation, quality and quantity of food supplied to the pupils of said Jones Academy, and to examine and investigate such other feature in the management and conduct of said school as in the minds of said Commission shall seem expedient and necessary to the interests of said school.

Be it further resolved, That said Commission shall make written report to the present session of the Council as soon as convenient after their work and that said Commission shall be entitled to only their actual expenses in going to and returning from said Academy, and this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
