AN ACT
AUTHORIZING THE NATIONAL AUDITOR TO ISSUE A WARRANT IN FAVOR OF HIMSELF.

Assembled: That the National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue his warrant in the sum of Thirty-three dollars and ninety cents upon the National Treasurer in favor of himself to cover actual expenses of the Auditor in furnishing the regular and special session of the Council with necessary stationery, and the Treasurer shall pay the same.

SECTION 2. Be it further enacted, That the sum of Thirty-three dollars, and ninety cents, is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay Simon H. Woods, National Auditor, as hereinbefore stated, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
