

A REPORT
OF THE COMMITTEE ON FINANCE REGARDING TANDY K. WALKER,

We, your Committee on Finance, to whom was referred the matter of Tandy K. Walker, Inspector on the Kansas City, Pittsburg and Gulf Rail Road, beg leave to report that ~~the~~ said Tandy K. Walker has failed ~~and wholly~~ ~~refused~~ to submit to your Committee a report of his collection of moneys on said Rail Road, or to submit any report of whatever nature to your Committee, that your Committee has sent to said Tandy K. Walker requesting a report of his actions and collection for the years of 1898 and 1899, and ~~he has refused and wholly~~ failed to appear before your Committee at this session of Council, Wherefore, your Committee recommend the passage of the following,

RESOLUTION

Be It Resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled; That the Principal Chief be and he is hereby instructed and required to make demand of the said Tandy K. Walker, Inspector on the Kansas City, Pittsburg and Gulf Rail Road, for an accounting to the Choctaw Nation of all moneys collected by him as said Inspector for the said Nation, and that said accounting, if made during the vacation of the General Council, shall be submitted to the Principal Chief to be by him submitted to the General Council at its next meeting.

Be it further Resolved, That should the said Tandy K. Walker fail or refuse after ten days notice hereof to submit his report or make an accounting as herein provided, or should said report or accounting when submitted show a deficit in the amount collected, the Principal Chief, after a reasonable time for making good said deficit, is authorized and required to report the matter to the United States Court authorities to be dealt with according to the laws thereof, and this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
