Be it enacted by the General Council  
of the Choctaw Nation assembled: that  
citizenship in the Choctaw Nation is here-  
by conferred upon James Patterson  
and his wife - Sophronia Patterson and  
their children Robert and Jesse James Pat-  
terson; upon Walton Patterson and his  
wife Martha Jane Patterson; and upon  
Babe Thompson; and they shall be re-  
spected accordingly, and this act shall  
take effect and be in force from and  
after its passage.
