

An Act for the relief of
Thomas W. Hunter

Where-as, it appears that after examining the report of Thomas W. Hunter, Superintendent of Armstrong, Orphan & Home Academy, the committee find that said Thomas W. Hunter had to expend the sum of Two Hundred and fifty two ~~dollars~~ and twenty cents, on account of the scarcity of ready money to meet the demands of the school, therefore; Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled; that the sum of \$252.20, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any school fund in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the relief of Thomas W. Hunter.

Sec 2. Be it further enacted; That the National Auditor is hereby authorized and instructed to issue his warrant on the Treasurer for said amount, and the Treasurer shall pay the same, and this act take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval to name
