To the General Council.

Your Committee to whom was referred the Report of Special Committee appointed by Principal Chief to Examine the Report of Daniel Miller former District Trustee 3rd District beg leave to report as follows.

We find that National Treasurer C. E. Nelson paid to M^r Miller $\$5.\frac{30}{100}$ more than the Appropriation allows, and that M^r Dan^l Miller over paid the sum of $28.\frac{99}{100}$.

We therefore offer the following resolution and recommend its passage.

Be it resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, That the District Trustee of the 3rd District is hereby authorized to reserve $\$5.\frac{30}{100}$ out of the $\$28.\frac{99}{100}$ and pay to M^r Miller the sum of $\$23.\frac{69}{100}$ and that the bonds of said Daniel Miller be cancelled, his accounts and reports being found to be true and correct; and that this Resolution take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
