CHOCTAW NATION.

AN ACT To reimburse D. C. McCurtain.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Council of the choctaw Nation Assembled: Section 1. That the sum of Sixty-five Dollars and twenty-five cents, (\$65. 25,), be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to reimburse D.C.McCurtain for expenses incurred and services rendered as Commissioner to the Chickasaw Nation for the purpose of arranging for a commission to meet a commission of the Choctaw Nation.

SEction 2. Be it further enacted: That the National Auditor shall issue his warrant to the said D. C. McCurtain for said amount, and the National Treasurer shall pay the same, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
