That the sum of eighteen dollars, and ten cents, (\$18.10,), be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasurynot otherwise appropriated to reimburse H.P. Ward, and T.W. Hunter for expenses in curred by them on their mission to the Jones Academy for the purpose of investigating the condition of the school.

Section 2. Be it further enacted , That the National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue his warrant for thesaid sum on the National Treasurer and the Treasurer shall pay the same to H.P.Ward, and T.W.Hunter, andtthis act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
