CHOCTAW NATION.

AN ACT

To reimburse H.P.Ward, and T.W.Hunter.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled:

Section 1. That the sum of eighteen dollars, and ten cents, (\$18.10,) be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated to reimburse H.P.Ward, and T.W.Hunter for expenses incurred by them on their mission to the Jones Academy for the purpose of investigating the condition of the school.

Section 2. Be it further enacted, That the National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue his warrant for the said sum on the National Treasurer and the Treasurer shall pay the same to H.P.Ward, and T.W.Hunter, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
