CHOCTAW NATION.

AN ACT appropriating money to dfray the expenses of three Commissioners.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled; Section 1. That the sum of Three hundred dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to defray the expenses of a Commission of three Choctaws by blood, who are appointed by the Principal Chief, to confer with a like Chickasaw Commission.

Section 2. Be it further enacted, That the National Auditor shall issue his warrant on the National Treasurer for said amount, or so much thereof as necessary, to defray the expenses of said Commissioners, and this agt take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
