Sec. 1. That the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasurn not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of removing inryduers without the limts of the Choctaw Nation.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted thatupon the certificate of the Principal Chief the National Auditor shall issue hiswarrant for said amount or so much thereof as may be necessary upon the National Treasurer and he shall pay the same, and this act shall take effect and be in forc from and after its passage and approval.
