

Bill No.38.

An act appropriating money for the removal of intruders:-

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation,  
assembled:-

Sec. 1. That the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars is hereby appropriated out of any money in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purpose of removing intruders without the limits of the Choctaw Nation.

Sec. 2. Be it further enacted that upon the certificate of the Principal Chief the National Auditor shall issue his warrant for said amount or so much thereof as may be necessary upon the National Treasurer and he shall pay the same, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
