

An Act requiring County Treasurers to make
and Publish Quarterly Reports

Be it enacted by the General Council of
the Choctaw Nation Assembled;

Sec. I

That the County Treasurers of the several
Counties of the Choctaw Nation, be and
the same are hereby required, and it
shall be their duty to make a detailed
& sworn report, quarterly of all
monies received by them and the
disbursements thereof; that all
debts & assets due to and of
the several Counties may clearly
& distinctly appear and that the
County Treasurers shall have said
Reports, published in some News-
Paper in the Choctaw Nation
most convenient to them,

Sec. II

That the respective County Judges
of any and all Counties making
such Reports, shall order the County
Treasurer to pay, if necessary, for said
publications.

Sec. III

That any County Treasurer failing or
refusing to comply with the provisions
of this act shall be subject to immediate
removal from office by the Principal
Chief,

Sec. IV

Be it further enacted, that
this act take effect and
