A Resolution accepting the report of J.H. Miller, Collector for the Third District for the four quarters ended June 30, 1900.

Your committee, to whom was referred the report of J.H. Miller, Collector for the Third District of the Choctaw Nation, have carefully examined said report, and find that it covers the following quarters:

Quarter ended	September 30,	1899,
"	"	December 31, "
"	"	March 31, 1900,
"	"	June 30, "

and shows that the total amount due the Choctaw Nation is \$7,555.55. The Committee's examination of said report shows that the total amount actually due is \$7,562.93, or a shortage of \$7.38. The Committee was furnished satisfactory evidence of the payment by Mr. Miller into the Treasury of the Choctaw Nation of the amount due according to his report, and of the amount of the shortage, and would, therefore, recommend the adoption of the following resolution:

Be it Resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled:

That the report of J.H. Miller, Collector for the Third District, be and the same is hereby accepted as true and correct, and that this resolution take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
