RESOLUTION.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED:

That the messages of Honorable Green McCurtain, retiring Principal Chief of the Choctaw Nation, and Honorable G. W. Dukes, present Principal Chief of the Choctaw Nation, in so far as they relate to citizenship matters, be adopted and made a part of this resolution, and that the same, together with this resolution, and other important matters relating to citizenship, be printed in pamphlet form, and sent abroad as an expression of our people upon this the most important of all questions affecting their property and general welfare;

SECOND: That the Congress of the United States, and the proper Departments of the government ofk the United States, in the light of this information as to the frauds perpetrated upon us, be earnestly requested to provide adequate relief.
