AN ACT
FOR THE RELIEF OF THOMAS WATSON
ET AL.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled:
That the sum of (\$106.00), One hundred and six dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated to pay the balance of the indebtedness of Thomas Watson, Abner Clay and Simon Taylor, to the attorneys Easton & Stewart for defend^{ing} them in the United States Court when they were ^{charged} with the murder of William Goings, whom they had legally executed in the regular discharge of their official duties.

That the National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue his warrant on the National Treasurer and he shall pay the same, and that this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
