Sir:

You are respectfully advised that an act of the National Council of the Choctaw Nation, approved by the Principal Chief on October 24, 1900, and entitled -

"An Act appropriating money to pay W. H. Isherwood,"
- was disapproved by the President of the United States on December 20, 1900, for the reason that the provisions of the agreement with the Choctaws and Chickasaws, as set out in section 29 of the act of Congress approved June 28, 1898 (30 Stat., 495), require that said royalties shall be disbursed under rules and regulations of the Secretary of the Interior, which regulations have been promulgated by the Department.

Mr. Isherwood should be advised to present his claim to this Department for adjustment.

The act above referred to, bearing the disapproval of the President, is returned herewith.
