An act changing an election precinct in Wade County

Be it enacted by the General Council  
of the Choctaw Nation Assembled:

That the election precinct in Wade County,  
known as Pleasant Hill precinct, be and the  
same is hereby removed and located at  
Wadesville school house one mile ~~south~~, East,  
and to be called and known as Wadesville  
election precinct; And all future elections  
shall be held there;  
And this act shall take effect and be in  
force from and after its passage
