

An Act changing an election
precinct in Gaines County.

Be it enacted by the general
Council of the Choctaw nation
assembled: That the election precinct
in Gaines County, known as Hartshorn
precinct, be and the same is hereby
removed and located at Mountain
station, eight miles south-east,
and to be called and known as
Mountain station election precinct;
and all future elections shall be
held there; and this act shall
take effect and be in force from
and after its passage.
