A Resolution accepting the report of C.J.Anderson, showing expenditures made out of the contingent fund allowed him as School Trustee for the **Second**District of the Choctaw Nation.

Your committee, to whom was referred the report of C.J. Anderson, School Trustee for the Second District of the Choctaw Nation, giving an itemized account of the expenditures made by him out of **his** contingent fund of \$75.00, during the fiscal year ended September 30, 1901, have carefully examined the report, and find that the total amount expended by him in the discharge of his official duties was \$54.25. To this amount Mr.Anderson added the discount at which he sold his national warrant. The discount was 20 per centum, or \$15.00,- making the total amount reported by him as having been expended \$69.25.

Your committee believes that National officers should not be allowed a credit for the discount at which they may dispose of the warrants paid them as salaries or allowed them as contingent expenses. Your committee further believes that the difference between Mr.Anderson's contingent fund and the amount expended by him in the discharge of his official duties, or \$20.75, should be refunded to the National Treasury.

We would, therefore, recommend the adoption of the following resolution:

Be it Resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled,-

Section 1. That the report of C.J.Anderson, School Trustee for the Second District of the Choctaw Nation, showing the amounts expended by him out of his contingent fund of \$75.00, be, and the same is hereby, accepted as true and correct so far as it shows amounts expended by him in the discharge of his official duties, or to the amount of \$54.25.

Section 2. That the National Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to ~~make~~ demand on Mr.Crawford for the balance of his contingent fund now on hand, or \$20.75, and to report to the next General Council the result of his actions under this resolution.

Section 3. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
