

A Resolution accepting the annual report of S.H.Woods, National Auditor, for the fiscal year ended September 30, 1900.

Your committee, to whom was referred the annual report of S.H.Woods, National Auditor, for the fiscal year ended September 30, 1900, have carefully examined the report, and find that Mr. Woods issued national warrants to the amount of \$108.00 on certificates illegally issued by county and district clerks. For that reason, his report was not accepted by the General Council of October, 1900. Mr.Woods has collected the above amount from the parties who illegally issued the certificates, and has submitted national warrants to your committee to the amount of \$109.00, making a difference of One Dollar in favor of Mr.Woods, which amount your committee has refunded to him. The national warrants thus turned in have been canceled by your committee.

We would, therefore, respectfully recommend the adoption of the following resolution:

Be it Resolved by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled, -

Section 1. That the annual report of S.H.Woods, National Auditor, for the fiscal year ended September 30, 1900, be, and the same is hereby accepted as true and correct.

Section 2. That this resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
