To the General Council,

Your Committee to whom was referred, the petition of the citizens of Pushmataha District, praying for a change in the present location of the Circuit Court grounds in said District, have carefully examined the same and would, ask the adoption of the following bill:

Be it enacted by the general Council of the Choctaw Nation assembled, That the place located by law for the Circuit Court grounds of Pushmataha District be and the same is hereby changed, and located at a point where Hon. R. S. W. Folsom caused a court house to be built for said District, and that all acts or parts of acts heretofore passed coming in any manner in conflict with the provisions of this act be and the same are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
