

AN ACT amending the law relating to the appointment of National Lighthorsemen.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED,-

Section 1. That the law relating to the appointment of National Lighthorsemen be, and the same is hereby, so amended as to provide for the appointment by the Principal Chief of thirty National Lighthorsemen, instead of nine, and that said appointments shall be made without respect to District.

Section 2. That the law relating to National Lighthorsemen shall remain in full force and effect, except as herein amended.

Section 3. That this act shall be in force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
