APPROPRIATING MONEY TO PAY THE EXPENSE OF THE SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE  
SUPPLEMENTARY AGREEMENT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION, IN REGULAR  
SESSION ASSEMBLED

Section 1 That the sum of five hundred and ten dollars (\$510.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay the expense of the special election, held September 25, 1902, on the Supplementary Agreement.

Section 2 Be it further enacted that all acts or parts of acts coming in conflict with this act, is hereby repealed, and this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage .

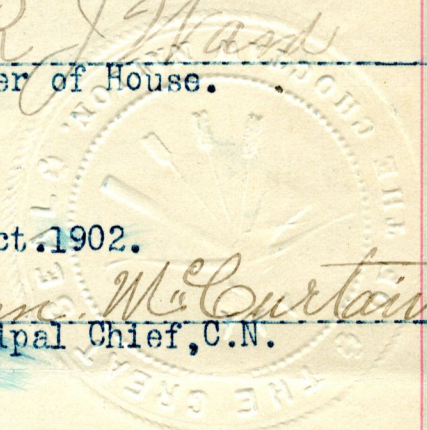

Be it enacted by the General Council  
of the Choctaw Nation in regular  
Session assembled -

Sec 1. That the sum of Five Hundred  
and Ten dollars (\$510<sup>00</sup>) or so  
much thereof as may be necessary  
be and the same is hereby appropriated  
out of any money in the National  
Treasury not otherwise appropriated  
to pay the Expense of the Special Election  
held September 25/1902 on the  
Supplementary Agreement.

Sec 2. Be it further enacted that  
all acts or parts of acts coming in  
conflict with this act is hereby  
repealed. And this act shall take  
effect and be in force from  
and after its passage.
