To the General Council.

Your Committee on Schools to whom was referred the report of C. A. Gray, late Superintendent of New Hope Seminary for the year ending July 31. 1885, find that \$2757<sup>00</sup> was appropriated by the last Council for building purposes, and that said Gray credits himself with the above amount in full. He also claims a credit for \$805<sup>35</sup> expended for building purposes, which should have been merged into, and made a part of the former amount; or in other words he has credited himself with the latter amount twice; showing a deliberate intention of perpetrating a fraud upon the Choctaw Nation.

We also find that he failed to charge himself with \$79<sup>63</sup> turned over to him by Jno. P. Turnbull, and recommend the passage of the following resolution
