ANACT

IN RELATION TO THE GREAT SEAL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION

Whereas, the Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation, heretofore used, has been lost, destroyed or misplaced, THEREFORE:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION, ASSEMBLED:

Section 1 That the principal Chief of the Choctaw Nation be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to procure a seal, embodying an exact duplicate of the design of the Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation heretofore used, and so lost, destroyed or misplaced; and when so procured, said seal and none other shall be the great seal of the Choctaw Nation.

Section 2 That there is hereby appropriated therefor out of any funds in the Treasury of the Choctaw Nation, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ten dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; and the National Auditor shall tissue his warrant for said amount, and the National Treasurer shall pay the same.

Section 1. That the National Secretary of the Choctaw
Nation be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to procure
a seal embodying an exact duplicate of the design of the Great
Seal of the Choctaw Nation heretofore and used and so lost,
destroyed or misplaced; and when so procured, said seal and none
ther, shall be the Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation;

Section 2. That there is hereby appropriated therefor our of any funds in the Treasury of the Choctaw Nation not otherwise appropriated, the sum of Ten Dollars, or so much the reof as may be ne cessary; and the National Auditor shall is sue his warrant for said amount, and the National Treasurer shall pay the same.
