IN RELATION TO THE GREAT SEAL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION
- - - - -

Whereas, the Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation, heretofore used, has been lost, destroyed or misplaced, THEREFORE:

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION, ASSEMBLED:

Section 1 That the principal Chief of the Choctaw Nation be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to procure a seal, embodying an exact duplicate of the design of the Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation heretofore used, and so lost, destroyed or misplaced; and when so procured, said seal and none other shall be the great seal of the Choctaw Nation.

Section 2 That there is hereby appropriated therefor out of any funds in the Treasury of the Choctaw Nation, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of ten dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary; and the National Auditor shall issue his warrant for said amount, and the National Treasurer shall pay the same.

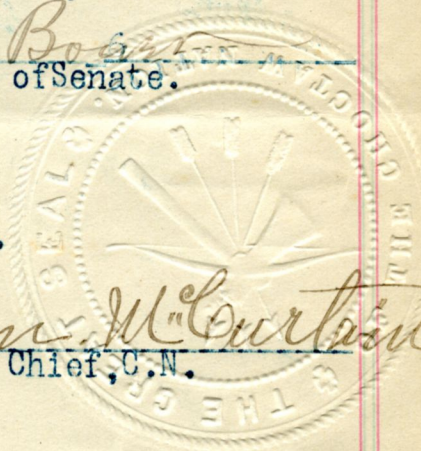

An act in relation to the Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation.

WHEREAS, The Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation heretofore
uses, has been lost, destroyed or misplaced, THEREFORE

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation
assembled:

Section 1. ^{Principal Chief} That the National Secretary of the Choctaw
Nation be, and he is hereby authorized and directed to procure
a seal embodying an exact duplicate of the design of the Great
Seal of the Choctaw Nation heretofore ~~be~~ used and so lost,
destroyed or misplaced; and when so procured, said seal and none
other, shall be the Great Seal of the Choctaw Nation;

Section 2. That there is hereby appropriated therefor
out of any funds in the Treasury of the Choctaw Nation not
otherwise appropriated, the sum of Ten Dollars, or so much there-
of as may be necessary; and the National Auditor shall issue his
warrant for said amount, and the National Treasurer shall
pay the same.
