NOW THEREFORE
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAWNATION, IN EXTRAORDINARY SESSION ASSEMBLED:

That the Principal Chief be authorized to communicate with said prisoners, in the various United States Prisons, to the end that said prisoners mayselect suitable persons to represent them in the selection of their allotments, andin the drawing of the money that may be due them, as Choctaw Indians.

That this resolution shat take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
