I respectfully return herewith an act of the National Council of the Choctaw Nation, approved by the Principal Chief December 12, 1902, creating an allotting commission, which was disapproved by the President, as shown by the endorsement thereon, February 28, 1903, for the reason that the Department believes the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes is amply able to make the allotments in the Choctaw Nation without the assistance of such commission.
