REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED.

Sec.1 That the Chairman of the Finance Committee shall appoint a clerk for the said committee whose duty it shall be to make and keep a full record of the work of said committee.

Sec.2 Be it further resolved: That the clerk of the said Finance Committee shall receive for his services five dollars (\$5.00) per day; that the National Auditor shall issue his warrant for actual services, and the Treasurer shall pay the same, and this resolution shall take effect and go in force from and after its passage and approval.
