

AND ACT FOR THE RELIEF OF DOCTOR J R JONES AND WIFE.

Be it enacted by the General Council of the Choctaw Nation Assembled;

Sec I That the sum of Two Hundred (\$ 220⁰⁰) and Twenty Dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any ~~money~~ funds in the National Treasury not otherwise appropriated, to pay Doctor J R Jones and wife for board and tuition for three Choctaw girls during the scholastic year of 1897 and 1898.

Sec 2. Be it further enacted that the National Auditor is hereby authorized to issue his warrant and the National Treasurer to pay the same, and that this ACT take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
