ESTABLISHING THE OFFICE OF CHOCTAW CITIZENSHIP COMMISSION, AND THE OFFICE OF CUSTODIAN OF RECORDS AND EXOFFICIO CLERK OF SAID COMMISSION, AND REPEALING THE LAW CREATING THE SAME.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION, IN
REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED.

Sec.1 That an Act creating a Commission to accompany and assist the Dawes Commission in making a roll of the Choctaw Citizens and also an act amendatory thereto approved October 22, 1900, creating the office of custodian of the citizenship records and exofficio Clerk of said Choctaw Citizenship Commission ^{is hereby abolished and the law repealed} ~~be~~ and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec.2 Be it further enacted that all acts amendatory, and parts of acts and resolutions relating thereto, are hereby repealed and that this law shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
