Accepting THE ANNUAL REPORT OF PETER J. HUDSON, NATIONAL AUDITOR,
FOR THE FISCAL YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 1903.

Your Finance Committee, to whom was referred the annual report of Peter J. Hudson, National Auditor, for the fiscal year ended September 30, 1903, beg leave to state that we have carefully examined the same and find that the auditor has conformed to the law in the issuance of all warrants and we therefore recommend that his report be accepted as true and correct.

We further find that said Auditor did issue a warrant, for the sum of three hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$325.00) on court scrip fraudulently issued by the Clerk of the Third Judicial District of the Choctaw Nation, said scrip being issued by said Clerk and appearing regular on its face your committee believe that the action of the Auditor in issuing said warrant, legally justifiable, under the circumstances mentioned. We therefore recommend the adoption of the following resolution:
