ASKING THE ENROLLMENT OF DELINQUENT CHOCTAWS.

To

THE HONORABLE SECRETARY OF THE INTERIOR:

WHEREAS, many bona fide Choctaw Indians have failed to secure enrollment of their names on the citizenship rolls now in the custody of the Honorable Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes; and

Whereas, The unquestioned right of the persons whose names are included in this resolution is such, as to remove all doubt as to the genuineness of their citizenship; Therefore

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED.

That the Honorable Secretary of the Interior be respectfully resquested to take whatever action deemed neccessary to enroll the names of the following persons as members of the Choctaw Nation: to-wit;

Morris Battiest, a full blood Choctaw boy, resides at Hartshorne I T; Alice E James age II; Maggie E James age I5; Ellis E James age I2; Anna L James age IO; Evelina James age 9 years, all children of Emerson James, desceased, a half breed Choctaw who resided near Hartshorne, I T: Mary Mayantubbee, a Choctaw woman, resides in north part of Jackson County; Louie Hoper and Cibby Sullen her daughter, both Choctaw women, and reside near the forks of Boggy, Jackson County; Susan Lollen and daughter Sallie Willis and her son Loben Elapotubbee; all reside in Jacksfork County; Garage Colorel Control of Charles of Charles of the Car; Sherwill Frazier (known as Sam Frazier) resides in Cedar County; Adam Hicks son of Cephus Hicks Choctaw boy 5 years old and resides in Nashoba County; Sarley Charles and Cilly Charles both Choctaws and reside in Red River County; JOHN WILLIS full blood Choctaw resides in Boktuklo County; Rhoda Mishaya, resides in Towson County; Johnson Jacob full blood Choctaw resides at Lane I T

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT THIS RESOLUTION TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS PASSAGE AND APPROVAL.
