RESOLUTION

REQUIRING ALF McCAY, UNITED STATES INDIAN POLICEMAN, TO PRESENT ITEM-IZED STATEMENT AND VOUCHERS SHOWING EXPENSES

INCURRED IN MOVING CATTLE FROM THE

CHOCTAW NATION.

We, Your Finance Committee, to whom was referred the account of Alf McCay, United States Indian Policeman, for expenses incurred in moving cattle from the Choctaw Nation, beg to report that we have carefully gone over the same and find that the account is not itemized, and that there are no vouchers accompanying same.

We therefore recommend that the following resolution be adopted.

BE IT RESOLVED

BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION ASSEMBLED.

That Alf McCay, United States Indian Policeman, be required to present itemized statement of the expenses incurred by him in removing cattle from the Choctaw Nation, and that he be required to present vouchers covering same; and that this resolution take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
