

AN ACT

ABOLISHING THE OFFICE OF SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS AND REPEALING
THE LAW IN RELATION THERETO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL COUNCIL OF THE CHOCTAW NATION, IN
REGULAR SESSION ASSEMBLED.

Sec.1 That the office of Superintendent of Schools is hereby abolished; and all that portion of Chapter 1, Sec. 1, Page 292 of Durant's Code, referring to the board of Education be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec.2 Be it further enacted that all acts or parts of acts and acts amendatory, and resolutions relating thereto are hereby repealed, and that this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.
